

## F.A.Q.

**Who will be chaperoning my teenager?** Students are accompanied by NDPA teachers and administration, Spanish teachers/tour guides, and their Spanish host family.

**How much does the trip cost and what does it cover?** The trip costs \$3500 which covers: \$1500 airfare, \$750 language school/daily excursions/5 night host family stay, \$600 hotels/3 meals per day including meals during layovers, \$650 transportation/travel insurance/Spain jacket, backpack, and travel journal.

**Should my student bring extra money?** Yes, we encourage each student to purchase Euros (in Utah) for souvenirs and snacks. For your convenience, a group Euro order will be placed through NDPA in February.

**Can parents attend?** Parents are welcome to shadow our experience, however, parents do not qualify as school chaperones.
