



EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES POLICY

Bonneville Academy supports student participation in extracurricular activities as a vital component of educational development. This policy establishes clear eligibility, conduct, and safety expectations for student involvement in school-sponsored extracurricular programs.

Equal Access

Participation in extracurricular activities is open to all students without regard to race, gender, religion, national origin, disability, or other protected status, in accordance with applicable federal and state nondiscrimination laws.

Eligibility Requirements

- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and have no failing grades during the eligibility period.
- Students must be in good behavioral standing, not under suspension, and not referred for major disciplinary infractions.
- Students must attend all scheduled classes on the day of the activity unless excused by administration.

Conduct and Safety

All students participating in extracurricular activities are expected to follow the school's Code of Conduct. Any instances of hazing, bullying, substance use, or unsafe behavior may result in removal from the activity and further disciplinary action. Parent or guardian permission is required for participation in any off-campus events.

Supervision

All school-sponsored extracurricular activities must be supervised by a designated staff member. Staff sponsors must ensure student safety, attendance, and adherence to school policies. When appropriate, staff should hold current CPR/First Aid certification.

Appeals

Students or parents may appeal ineligibility decisions in writing to the school director. A review process will be conducted, and a final decision will be made within a reasonable timeframe.

Prohibited Organizations

Fraternalities, sororities, or secret societies are not permitted at Bonneville Academy.
