



HUMAN SEXUALITY INSTRUCTION POLICY

Bonneville Academy is committed to providing education that supports student development and aligns with Utah law and State Board of Education rules. This policy outlines procedures and requirements for instruction related to human sexuality as required by Utah Code §53G-10-402 and USBE Rule R277-474.

Parental Notification and Consent

Parents must be notified in advance and provide prior written consent before their child may participate in any human sexuality instruction. Consent is required for each program annually and must use a form that complies with state guidelines.

Instructional Requirements

- All human sexuality instruction must be factual, medically accurate, and free from religious, ethnic, or gender bias.
- No advocacy of sexual activity, contraceptive use, or expressive sexual behavior is permitted.
- Abstinence is emphasized as the only sure method of preventing sexually transmitted diseases and pregnancy.

Educator and Guest Instructor Training

- Teachers and guest presenters must attend state-sponsored training prior to delivering human sexuality instruction.
- Educators must be approved by the school's director and trained on policy and curriculum content.

Curriculum Review Committee

Bonneville Academy will establish a curriculum review committee composed of parents, educators, and administrators. The committee will review all human sexuality materials and guest presentations for compliance with law and policy.

Student Exemptions and Alternative Assignments

Parents may exempt their student from any portion of human sexuality instruction without academic penalty. Alternative learning assignments will be provided where applicable.

Complaints and Feedback

Bonneville Academy shall maintain a log of parent complaints or feedback related to human sexuality instruction and report summary information as required.
