



SCHOOL LAND TRUST FUNDS POLICY

Formation of a Charter Trust Land Council

The Bonneville Academy Board of Directors shall implement and approve a Charter Trust Land Council comprised of a two-person majority of elected parents, grandparents, or legal guardians of students enrolled at Bonneville Academy. Community members and school employees may also serve on the council as long as the parent majority is maintained. A parent, grandparent, or legal guardian of a student enrolled at Bonneville shall serve as chair or co-chair of the council in accordance with Utah Code §53G-7-1205(6). The School Director shall attend meetings as a non-voting member, consistent with R277-477.

Council members shall be elected by secret ballot by the school community. The council shall consist of no fewer than four and no more than six parents and no fewer than two and no more than four school employees. Terms shall be two years, and members may serve no more than two consecutive terms.

The council shall elect its own executive members.

Duties of the Council

1. Identify the school's most critical academic needs.
2. Recommend a course of action to address the identified needs.
3. Specify the programs, practices, materials, or equipment necessary to implement the school's Success Plan and improve student performance.
4. Outline how the School LAND Trust allocation will be used to enhance or improve academic excellence.
5. Collaborate with students, families, and educators to incorporate safety principles at the school.
6. Hold at least one annual discussion with school administrators to coordinate safety efforts at the school level.

Plan Approval and Public Reporting

The plan, as developed by the Charter Trust Land Council, must be presented to and approved by the Bonneville Academy Board of Directors and submitted through the USBE School LAND Trust Program portal. The plan is subject to review by the school's authorizer, currently the State Charter School Board.

Bonneville Academy shall implement the approved plan, provide ongoing support for its execution, and publicly report how the School LAND Trust funds were used to implement the plan. The school shall prepare and present an annual report to the Board of Directors at the end of each school year detailing fund usage and the results achieved. All information shall be submitted through the USBE School LAND Trust portal.
