

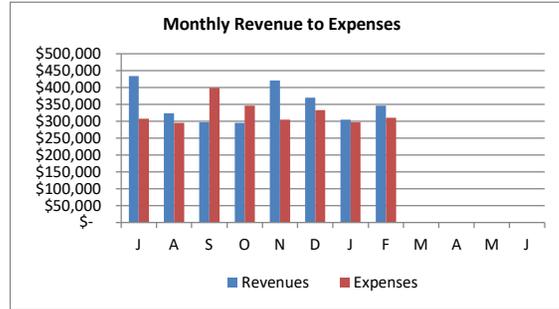


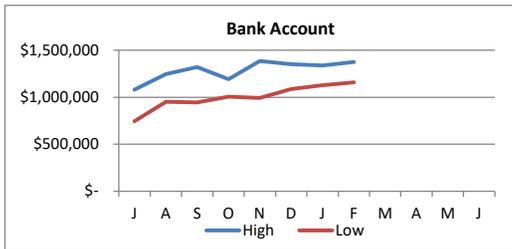

CASH RESERVES ENROLLMENT


