For safety, please note the following important details:

- 1. No student checkouts will be allowed at any time on October 31st unless it is for reasons other than the parade.**
- 2. For student safety students must not be taken during the parade or from the parade route.**
- 3. A list of students being checked out after the parade will be given to teachers so those students can be brought to the office once the parade ends.**
- 4. Notifying your student's teacher will not count – the office must be notified directly for it to be recorded.**
- 5. If the front office is not notified by October 30th, your student will remain at school and be released at 12:45 p.m. with the rest of the students who are not being checked out early.**

Grades Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th will receive vision screenings. If your student is not listed and you would like them to be tested, please call the front office or email info@bonnevilleacademy.org. You have until October 27th to sign up. An opt-out form is included; to opt out, fill it out and return it or email it to the school.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student's school will soon be conducting vision screenings in accordance with the Utah School Vision Screening Policy. Friends for Sight is a local nonprofit organization that specializes in vision screening, and FFS staff and volunteers will be on hand to assist with the process.

For the most accurate results, if your student wears prescription glasses or contacts, please have them wear them on the day of the screening. Screenings are intended to find out if the student has the tools they need to see clearly at school, so it's ideal to test the student's best possible corrected vision.

If your child cannot see at the appropriate distance for their age, or fails a SPOT machine screening, a referral form will be sent home with your child. This sheet will recommend that a full eye exam for your child should be a priority. Please remember that a vision screening is not a substitute for a complete eye exam and vision evaluation by an eye doctor.

Since no child should be denied proper eye care because of finances, Friends for Sight has several partnerships that provide free eye exams and glasses for those who qualify for financial assistance.

Queridos Padres o Guardianes de familia,

La escuela de su estudiante pronto comenzará hacer las pruebas rápidas mandatorias por el código the Utah School Vision Screening Policy. Friends For Sights es una organización local sin fines de lucro que se especializa en realizar pruebas rápidas de visión, los empleados y voluntarios estarán asistiendo mano a mano con todo el proceso.

Para nosotros poder obtener los mejores resultados en las pruebas visuales es necesario que si su estudiante usa anteojos o contactos recetados los traigan puestos el día de la prueba rápida. Esto es crucial ya que cuando nosotros hacemos la prueba rápida es para descartar con seguridad a los estudiantes que realmente necesitan ayuda para poder ver, lo cual es una herramienta muy importante en la educación de su estudiante.

Si en dado caso su estudiante no puede ver la distancia apropiada para su edad, o no pasa la prueba con nuestra máquina llamada SPOT, Una carta de referencia será mandada a casa con su estudiante. Esta carta recomienda con urgencia que su Hijo/Hija necesita una Examen Completo de la Vista con un Oculista lo más antes posible. Favor de tener en cuenta que esta prueba rápida no sustituye ni es un Examen Completo hecho por un Oculista profesional.

La prueba rápida administrada por Voluntarios y Empleados es solo diseñada para descartar y encontrar a los estudiantes que tienen problemas para ver y necesitan ser referidos con un Oculista. Ya que a ningún niño se le debe negar el acceso a un buen cuidado visual basado en su estado financiero. Friends for Sight tiene varias asociaciones que se dedican a proveer Exámenes Visuales y Anteojos completamente gratis para aquellos que califiquen para asistencia financiera.

Si usted tiene cualquier duda o pregunta acerca de las pruebas visuales, a que edad se recomienda hacer un Examen visual completo o necesita alguna información adicional, Favor de contactarnos al (801) 524-2020 o visítenos en nuestra pagina web www.friendsforsight.org.
