Dress Down Day Guidelines

At LPA, Dress Down Days provide students with the opportunity to express themselves while maintaining a school-appropriate appearance. Students who do not participate in the dress down day will be expected to be in school uniform.

To ensure a positive and respectful environment, students and families should follow these guidelines:

Safe

- Clothing must not feature references to drugs, alcohol, gangs, or skulls.
- Shorts, skorts, and skirts must follow hemline guidelines (no more than 2 inches above the knee).
- Low-cut tops require an undershirt.
- No slippers
- Modesty rules apply at all times.

Engaged

- Clothing should fit appropriately—nothing overly tight or baggy.
- Shirts must cover shoulders and midribs.

Respectful

- Attire must align with the LPA Code of Conduct—nothing offensive or inappropriate.
- Clothing should be modest, clean, and in good repair (holes in jeans must follow hemline guidelines, no more than 2 inches above the knee).
- No pajamas
- Hats, sunglasses, and bandanas are not permitted.

Responsible

- Students are expected to understand and follow these guidelines. If attire does not meet expectations, they will be required to call home for a change of clothes.

By following these guidelines, students can enjoy Dress Down Days while maintaining a respectful and positive school environment.
