# Our Schedule

## Daily Schedule

Grades K-6

MTThF 8:30 am - 3:00 pm

Wednesday is early release: 8:30 am - 1:30 pm

Doors open at 8:10 am and students should be dropped off between 8:10 and 8:27. Students are considered tardy if they are not in their classrooms when school starts at 8:30 am. A warning bell sounds at 8:25 to encourage students to get quickly to class.

Afternoon carpool begins at 3:00 pm on MTThF and 1:30 pm on Wednesdays and any other designated early out days. Carpool duration is 15 minutes. Please arrive in time to have your child picked up within that 15 minute window.



# Carpool



It is important for all stakeholders to follow the carpool rules to dismiss each student safely and quickly. Please follow the direction of our staff at carpool as they guide and direct you. Be patient and respectful. The first few weeks of every year take a little longer as we train new families and students on our process. After the initial training period, carpool is smooth and efficient if everyone follows the procedures. Be sure to obtain your carpool card with your unique family call number and bring it with you EVERY time you pick up your student.

Odyssey Charter School believes that the best way to produce students who will be independent learners for life is through a classical education. A classical education uses history as its organizing outline, beginning with the ancients and progressing forward to the moderns in history, science, literature, art and music. Elementary students learn as many concepts as they can, emphasizing Western and world culture. These concepts are the basis of a life of learning.

# Attendance Matters!

We want our students at school every day, all day! Attendance matters! When a child attends school they get to engage with their peers and teachers, developing relationships and routines. They participate in classroom discussions and collaborative work as they learn valuable skills that help them become a contributing member of our community. When students miss school, they miss out on so much more than academics!



If a student misses just 10% of school, for ANY reason, they are considered chronically absent. This can translate into a student having difficulty learning to read by third-grade, achieving in middle school, and graduating from high school. Every day counts!

Being on time is also important. It sets the tone for the rest of the day and helps each student settle in to the expectations of the day. Late arrivals are considered a disruption to class.

# Uniforms

We believe uniforms are a necessary part of the distinctive learning environment parents will find at Odyssey Charter School. Uniforms improve the classroom learning environment; build citizenship and a sense of community in our children; and create a safe learning environment.

Uniforms must be worn during school hours, except under special circumstances as announced by the school. Uniforms must also be worn for all before and after school programs, including field trips and special school activities, and all tutoring and enrichment sessions, except on occasions when costumes may be required for dress rehearsals or performances. ## Uniform Tops

Navy, white, light yellow (not gold) or light blue long or short sleeve polo uniform style shirt with no visible logos.

## Uniform Bottoms

- Navy or khaki twill uniform pants, shorts, or skirts – no “pull on” style pants, joggers, or pants with visible back pockets or cargo pockets.



## Accessories

Black or brown belts are required for grades 3-6. Socks can be white, navy blue, khaki, or black. Shoes need to be neutral with no distracting designs.

## Outerwear

For extra warmth during the school day, students may wear the OCS hoodie or OCS sweatshirt, a plain navy zip up sweatshirt, or a solid navy or white sweater.
