

## FAQs

**Who will be chaperoning my student?** Students are accompanied by NDPA teachers and administration, Spanish teachers/tour guides, and their Spanish host family.

**How much does the trip cost and what does it cover?** The trip costs \*\$3,500 which covers: \$1,500 airfare; \$750 language school/daily excursions/5-night host family stay; \$600 hotels/3 meals per day including meals during layovers; \$650 transportation/travel insurance/Spain jacket, backpack, and travel journal. *(\*If prices continue to increase, we will revisit this total.)*

**Should my student bring extra money?** Yes, we encourage each student to purchase Euros (in Utah) for souvenirs and snacks. For your convenience, a group Euro order will be placed through NDPA in February.

**Can parents attend?** Parents are welcome to shadow our experience, however, parents do not qualify as school chaperones.

outlined requirements and a pre-determined rubric. Top submissions will be scored and judged by the Spain Study Abroad Committee, who have no ties to scholarship applicants.

Scholarships will be awarded the last day of school during the Closing Assembly and/or during the fall semester of the students' 9<sup>th</sup> grade year.
