# High School Registration Info for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students



## STUDENT ENROLLMENT FOR CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS

Welcome to Tooele County School District Registration. Follow these steps to register your high school student:

1. **Complete Registration:** Visit the [Registration/Enrollment page](https://www.tooeleschools.org/about-us/registration-enrollment) of the Tooele County School District website (<https://www.tooeleschools.org/about-us/registration-enrollment>). Click on “New Student – Kindergarten – Twelfth Grade Registration,” then select “K-12th Grade Registration and Enrollment.”
2. **Receive Credentials:** After submitting the registration information, students will be assigned a unique TCSD Student ID and a Skyward/SIS login with a temporary password. This information will be given to each student when Stansbury High School counselors visit your school in February 2026. **Registered students will be able to build their 2026-2027 schedule on March 12th @3:30pm.**

### Required Documents for Registration

Please upload the following documents online during registration:

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record
- Photo ID of parent or guardian
- Proof of Address, if current address is not on Photo ID (i.e., utility bill)
- Guardianship Form (if applicable)
- Legal Documents (if applicable)

**Enrollment will not be complete, allowing students to build their schedule for the following year, until all required documents are submitted.**

### Special Considerations

- If your child has an IEP or a 504 plan, submitting a copy of the plan (i.e., IEP summary) will help ensure appropriate class placement. Contact your current school for a copy of these documents.

### Out-of-Boundary Applications

Open Enrollment Period for the 2026-2027 school year: **November 15th to February 6th.**

- **Process:** Click on “Out of Boundary Request K-12” from the [Registration/Enrollment page](https://www.tooeleschools.org/about-us/registration-enrollment) of the Tooele County School District website (<https://www.tooeleschools.org/about-us/registration-enrollment>). Pay the \$5 non-refundable application processing fee and complete the Out-of-Boundary Request form during the open enrollment period. **(Be advised that applications will be evaluated for approval in compliance with Utah Code 53G-6-401 and TCSD Board Policy 5017. However, submission of an application regardless of when it is completed, does not guarantee approval.)** Families who submit requests within the open enrollment period will be notified of the decision no later than March 31st.

**Important:** Until an Out-of-Boundary request has been approved, the student’s enrollment defaults to the boundary school.

During the Skyward Arena Scheduling window, students will build a schedule for the school to which they are assigned. If the request gets approved at a later date, students/parents can schedule an appointment with their school counselor to build a schedule at the new school. Counselors are not contracted to work during the summer; they will return to school in August.

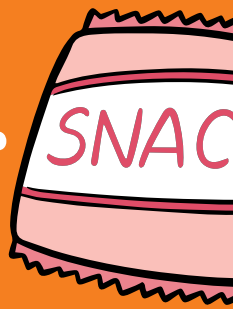

# Donations for After School Program

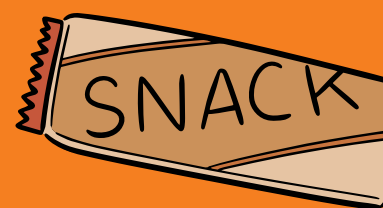


After School Program Snack Donations Needed!
