

# Teacher and Student Success Framework

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Pursuant to UCA 53G-7-1304, the InTech Collegiate Academy School Governing Board adopts the following framework within which school administration may develop a Teacher and Student Success Act Plan.

## Means Authorized for TSSA Plan

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The Governing Board authorizes any of the following means reasonably designed to improved school performance or student academic achievement

- School personnel stipends for taking on additional responsibility outside of a typical work assignment
- Professional learning
- Additional school employees, including counselors, social workers, mental health workers, tutors, media specialists, information technology specialists, or other specialists
- Technology
- Before or after school programs
- Summer school programs
- Community support programs or partnership
- Class size reduction strategies
- Augmentation of existing programs
- Any other strategy reasonably designed to improve school performance or student academic achievement

## Restrictions on TSSA Funding Uses

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Funding received pursuant to the school plan may not be used:

- To supplant funding for existing education programs
- For board or school-wide administration costs
- For capital expenditures

## Posting Requirements

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- This framework shall be submitted to the Utah State Board of Education
- This framework and its associated Plan will be posted on the school website

## Plan Goal

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In line with its school improvement plan, InTech's TSSA Plan will decrease the student non-pass rate on statewide standardized assessments by 10% annually, while also maintaining growth rates on Utah standardized testing above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile.
