Land Trust Plan 2026-2027

Academic Area

Early / Foundational Reading & Mathematics

Goal #1

By the end of the 2026-27 school year, 60% of Elevated students, who have been enrolled at least 2 school years, will be at or above grade-level benchmarks in Reading & Math. At least 60% of all students will have increased their foundational competencies (skills) in both Reading and Mathematics by 3%.

Measurement

Student progress will be measured by and need for intervention will be assessed by a combination of:

- State Standardized Tests (Acadience),
- School-based assessments (Star),
- Teacher-based summative assessments (Skills & Key Assignments), and/or
- Learning conferences with Education Coordinator, who is a licensed teacher, and
- Student portfolios including learning samples in core subject areas.

Action Plan

- Elevated Charter School will employ a Head of Assessment & Intervention and at least two (2) paraprofessionals dedicated to intervention, small group classes and support.
- Elevated Charter School's Learning Support Team (LST) will consist of Executive Director, Assistant Director, and Head of Assessment & Intervention. This team will meet monthly, or as needed, to address student needs brought by teachers and/or parents, and determine next steps to support each student.
- Assistant Director will work closely with Class Teachers to observe and coach as needed in implementing the School's instructional model of PCBL.
- The Assistant Director: Curriculum & Instruction will work closely with the Head of Assessment & Intervention, Class Teachers, and Education Coordinators, to identify students in need of Intervention within 6 weeks of the school year or date of enrollment.
