

InTech Collegiate Academy Graduation Requirements

Graduates from InTech will meet the following two requirements to receive a high school diploma:

Graduation Requirement #1: Complete/Receive First Credential (one of the following)

- 1) Concurrent Enrollment
 - Course in quantitative literacy
 - Course in writing
 - Two (2) courses in other general education categories
- 2) Industry Recognized Credentials
- 3) Youth Apprenticeship
- 4) Technical College Certificate
- 5) Career and Technical Education Pathway
- 6) Completion of 4.0 high school credit of “InTech Mission” courses*
 - i. AP, CE, EC, CTE, STEM, Honors, or Foreign Language

Graduation Requirement #2: Complete 26.0 High School Credits

- 7.0 elective credits (including any necessary to complete a “First Credential”)
- 19.0 USBE Required Credits

- 1 year of AP course work or a score of 3 or higher on an AP exam will equal 1.0 high school credits.
- Each college credit is equal to 0.33 high school credits.
- *For transfer students, 1.0 credits of mission is required per year of enrollment at InTech.
- **Students may substitute up to 0.5 credits of Arts and 1.0 credits of Healthy Lifestyles with Mission credits.

Modifications to Graduation Requirements

- 1) Per R277-700-7J, state graduation requirements may be modified for individual students when the modifications are consistent with the student's IEP or PCCR
 - b) Are maintained in the student file and include a parent/guardian signature.
 - c) Maintain the integrity and rigor expected for high school graduation.
 - d) Are approved for specific students by the InTech board
 - 2) College Course-work Equivalency to USBE courses
 - a. As a standing modification to the state core curriculum and in keeping with requirements to offer alternatives for demonstrating competency in the core curriculum (R277-705-3), the InTech Board approves the following courses as substitutions:
 - i. HIST 1700 American Civilizations (college course) may substitute for US History II (USBE course)
 - 3) Modification for children of US Defense Department Employees
 - a. To facilitate the on-time graduation from high school of a transferring DoD employee's 12th grade student, InTech will
 - i. Waive specific courses required for graduation if similar coursework has been satisfactorily complete by the transferring student, or
 - ii. InTech will provide an alternative means of acquiring the required coursework so that the transferring student may graduate on time
 - b. InTech must provide a reasonable justification for any waiver denials to the transferring student
